Czech consul general Daniel Kumermann was born in Prague, Czechoslovakia. In 1975, he obtained his Masters degree in English and philosophy from the Charles University in Prague. His work experience began as a computer programmer, a store clerk, a window cleaner and then a journalist. He was also a journalist for various Czech and English-language newspapers in Prague. In 1999, he began his service in the Czech Foreign Ministry as ambassador to Israel until 2003. He then worked in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Prague in the analytical department until 2006. He has been the Consul General of the Czech Republic in Los Angeles since 2006.
